

for county offices of education, early learning

county offices are the distribution layer for california preschool and tk. tiny signals is a writing layer the teachers in those classrooms can open the same morning, with no county contract, no per-seat license, and nothing to install.

the coe fit

a county office supports preschool and tk teachers across many districts and partner sites at once, each with a different sis, assessment portal, and communication tool.

tiny signals is not a system. it is a page a teacher opens that handles the writing layer the existing systems do not: the conference summary, the incident note, the daily handoff, the asq family letter, the drdp evidence sentence.

what it covers

- drdp-2025 measure language in plain words for the measures teachers actually rate each week.
- asq-3 and asq:se-2 prompts loaded by age window, with a family-friendly summary.
- deca strengths language and iep friendly write ups.
- daily handoff, incident log, and fifteen-minute conference write up.

what it is not

not a student information system, not a replacement for drdp tech, not a curriculum, not a parent billing or attendance tool. no county contract is required for a teacher to try it.

how a coe usually shares it

the simplest path is a single link in a monthly coordinator newsletter or a tk community of practice email. teachers open it on their own; no follow up is required from the county.
