mshs classrooms move with families. a child may be in the program for six weeks, six months, or a single season. tiny signals is a writing layer that travels with the family, in plain language and in a spanish mirror.

built for mobility

handoff notes a family can take to the next program. asq summaries written so another teacher can pick up where the last one left off.

bilingual by default

spanish mirror for every family-facing draft. a teacher writes once and a parent reads it in the language they prefer.

what it is not

not a child information system and not a replacement for mshs reporting. it is the writing layer for the family conversation.
